Profile Description

The first attempt to set up a form of higher education in the region of Moldova took place in 1562 when the Latin School in the village of Cotnari, near Iasi was founded. But it was only in 1813 when the scholar Gheorghe Asachi founded the first school for surveyors and civil engineers. This school can be considered the nucleus of the technical higher education in Moldova. Later on, the school is developed within the Michaelian Academy (1835), and afterwards within the University of Iasi, established in 1860.

Facilities: The existing spaces offer good conditions and facilities for the study of all the subjects in the curriculum. Besides the spaces allocated for Design classes, general courses and seminars, the Section benefits from an auditorium endowed with audio-visual facilities for specialized courses, an IT laboratory, endowed with specific hard and soft ware for Computer Aided Design (CAD) courses, a special room for the Study of Form, and from its own library.

The Specialization (Section) **Architecture** from Iasi was founded in 1970, at the same time with similar sections in Cluj and Timisoara. These sections were integrated within the Faculties of Civil Engineering of the above-mentioned university centers. In these sections the length of studies was of 3 years at the end of which he graduates became conductor architects. In 1990 the Ministry of Education approved that the activity of the Schools of Architecture in Iasi, Cluj and Timisoara be resumed, this time on the basis of a new academic status: length of studies - 6 years (full time courses) and the award of the degree of architect upon graduation. In 1993, as a result of a Romanian government decision, the School of Architecture in Iasi became a faculty in its own right.

The Faculty of Architecture fulfils specific didactic, as well as research and design tasks. It ensures the forming and training of future professional architects, who, after graduating, can choose to work in the fields of construction design, execution, exploitation or maintenance, in research and teaching or in administration. The aim of the faculty is to form and develop the students' abilities required in all related fields - architecture, urban planning, restorations, and interior architecture - design. Our avowed purpose is to form future professionals who will work in the North-Eastern part of Romania, in the old region of Moldavia, and this was indeed one of the main reasons why this specialization was re-introduced in our university in 1990.

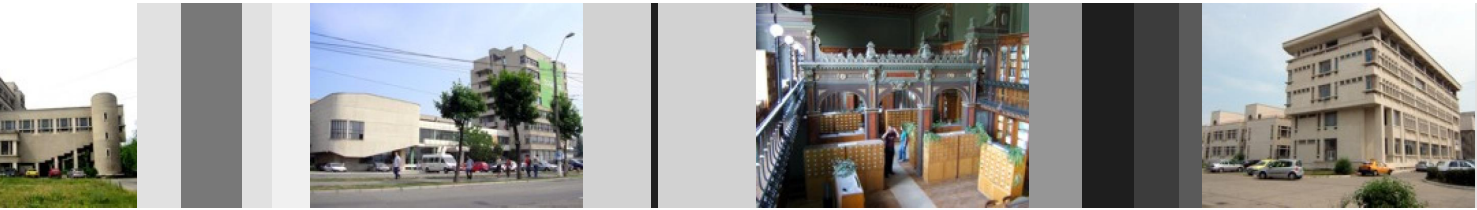
Structure of the Curriculum
