Letter of Motivation

„I have never left school, but i have always been an architect.“

Ever since i finished education, my professional life was a combination of practice and teaching. I believe this duality as being my source of energy and constant renewal.

Another duality was decisive on my personal development: whereas the education in Innsbruck/Austria was dominated by pragmatism, my postgraduate studies at Pratt Institute/New York where highly conceptual. My education made me realize the quality of „as well as“ instead of „either-or“.

Since the late eighties the world of architecture schools and the real world of architecture began to drift apart – students got prepared for a world that does not exist and the real world could not embrace the offer of the next generation architects. Today young architects are forced to decide on either to follow the establishment and the rules or become writers, thinkers, educators – the gap between practice and teaching got increasingly wider and mutual benefits are reduced to a minimum.

Through my own work i believe to be catalyst and ambassador for both: „practice and education“.

I would be very happy to bring in my experience from and connections to both „worlds“ as a Council Member of the EAAE to rebuild and strengthen the relationship between school and profession .
