#### New priorities of Schools of Architecture in the era of uncertainty

In the last years from the debate in the framework of our Meetings of Heads of European Schools of Architecture it became evident that we are entering an era in which our capacity to envisage and define the profile of the future architect becomes increasingly diminished and ineffective. This condition has



direct consequences on the way we have to structure the future of architectural education, as it is always directed by a certain conception of the ideal profile of an architect. Educating architects for an unstable, transformable, changing, adapting, fluid, sometimes hybrid, and more or less unpredictable profile, urges schools of architecture to redefine their educational strategies, to reformulate their curricula and to re-establish their principles and values related to their social role and mission. In this new educational environment new priorities for schools of architecture emerge which could be classified on four major axes:

Values, Context, Competences & Content.
