Competition open to students

EUROPEAN COMPETITION OF IDEAS

The European Commission is looking for an idea to give the buildings and building clusters that it occupies in the cities of Brussels and Luxembourg a symbolic common thread in the aim of making the Commission more visible and recognisable to the general public.

WHO CAN TAKE PART?

The competition is open to students enrolled at an institute of higher education in architecture, art, design or other discipline such as fine arts, graphic arts, visual communication, graphic design or a related discipline.



To enter, you must be an EU citizen and your educational establishment must be situated in one of the 27 EU Member States.

You must be aged 18 years or over.

You do not have to provide proof of your age, citizenship or enrolment at your educational establishment when you submit your entry or proposal, but you will be asked to do so if you are among the three finalists.

WHAT DO YOU HAVE TO DO?

You must first register by sending an e-mail stating your surname, first name, date of birth, e-mail address and the name and address of your school to ec-fil-rouge@ec.europa.eu before midnight, ...
