Initiating/supporting activities

Core activities deals with the essential role and mission of the organisation.

Initiating activities are events, networks and projects that the EAAE supports and eventually takes part in (permanent or temporarily) because this in accordance with the mission of the organisation and strengthens the core activities.

The EAAE are involved in:

Projects (example Erasmus+ projects)

Strategic Initiatives (example EAAE/ACE working party)

Events (examples EAAE yearly conference and GA, EAAE/ARCC conference)

- A secretariat in Hasselt that (today 20%) should be expanded.

- Activities financed from membership schools
