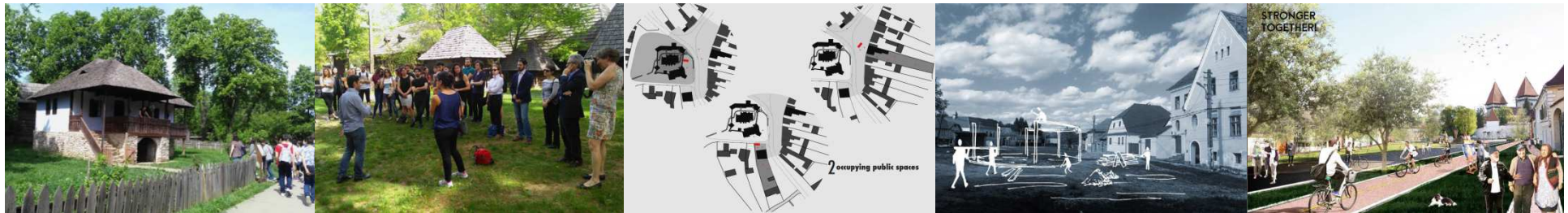
- Understanding and delimitation of the meaning of heritage.
