The fifteenth Meeting of Heads of Schools of Architecture in Europe will take place in Chania, Crete from Saturday 1 September 2012 (arrival day) to Tuesday 4 September 2012 (Wednesday 5 September departure day) and is entitled "Improving learning quality in architectural education environments".

The enhancement of the quality of learning appears to be a necessary condition for the improvement of architectural education in mere with less
