A unified text for the Charter on Architectural Research

In 2009 the EAAE set up a Research Committee to promote the issue of research in architecture. One of the objectives of the committee, among others, was to write a Research Charter.

In September 2011 a twofold document was presented at the General Assembly in Chania, consisting of a one-page "Declaration on Architectural Research" and a more detailed "Framework for Architectural Research". The Declaration was approved; the Framework was accepted as a clarifying text, meant to develop and extend the principles of the Declaration.



Since then, the Charter has served as an instrument for several initiatives. A research seminar in Winterthur (cf EAAE Newsletter 25) checked and verified its connection to actual architectural research practices in a variety of European Architecture schools; for the EU-advocacy group the Charter serves as a reference document in their lobbying for recognition and funding.

However, the triple concept of a Charter, a Declaration and a Framework gave rise to some confusion. Therefore a new proposal was worked out in the course of 2012, unifying both parts of the Charter into a single text, and including some concerns and remarks about the previous version.

It will be presented for approval at the General Assembly in Chania 2012.
