She is the co-author of many cultural projects focused on urban renewal, e.g. Lesson of Gothic, Water in the City, Dutch Builders of Gdańsk. She was an author of the EU-founded Intensive Program Bridging the City – Water in Architecture, Urban Spaces and Planning, co-author of Sensing the City – Designing Urban Experience and Art & Science – Synergy of Technology and Art in the City Spaces, guest lecturer in many European universities and the founder of the Floating Gallery project for Gdańsk.
