

EAAE Research Academy Meeting Ljubljana, 13-14 October 2016

With this message we kindly invite your school to attend and contribute to the EAAE Research Academy (RA) meeting hosted by the University of Ljubljana on Thursday 13 and Friday 14 October 2016. During this meeting the RA will discuss and focus on 2 important issues:

1. PhD education in Europe;
2. The database of periodicals.

PhD education in Europe

Most schools of architecture have now established PhD/doctoral programmes (third cycle). It has now become time to exchange information and learn from experiences. We suggest (amongst others) to discuss:

How is PhD education structured (duration, formal requirements, ...)?

How is it linked to the bachelor and master education?

How many PhD students are there in Architecture?

What is the role of PhD education in the schools of architecture?

What are the experiences in supervising PhD candidates?

What can we learn from each other? What can be improved?

Etc.

Within the Research Academy we intend to facilitate the exchange of experiences and knowledge as well as to establish a subnetwork for supervisors.

We call for participants presenting the situation in their school for 10' (followed by 5' discussion). Interested persons should contact Johan Verbeke at johan.verbeke@kuleuven.be before 5 October.

Furthermore, based on this discussion, we will discuss and prepare a questionnaire to map the third cycle education in Europe.

The database of Periodicals

This work intends to establish continuity with the work done by the Periodicals Working Group of the former EAAE Research Committee, in developing a database of architectural periodicals. Keeping this mapping publications updated is a first objective, giving greater visibility on the website to data collected, is the second.

During the Ljubljana meeting we intend to focus on two issues:

- A) *WHAT?_FRAMING THE DATABASE: FIELDS TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THE ARCHITECTURAL PERIODICALS*

The database was created a few years ago, and the data collected from each publication should be discussed under an updated perspective. What kind of publications will be accepted? Which will be the data required to submit a new publication? These and many other questions should set up a list of fields framing the database.

B) WHO & HOW?_WORKFLOW AND LAYOUT: FEEDING AND SHOWING THE UPDATED DATABASE

The continuous updating of the database needs an effective working structure, representing all the countries participants in the EAAE. The workflow should ensure continuous feeding of the database. At the same time, a decision should be made about the visibility of the database, both from the point of view of the infographics on the web, and from the dissemination of this new consultation tool for researchers.
